ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

An employee in this position may be called upon to do any or all of the following essential functions. These examples do not include all of the duties which the employee may be expected to perform. To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily.

1. Monitors guests during their utilization of the Splash Pad, and enforces safety rules and guidelines, to ensure a safe and enjoyable visitor experience.
2. Performs custodial and housekeeping activities of Splash Pad and landscaping duties of the Clinch Park area and surrounding parkland.
3. Ensure the proper communication and enforcement of rules.
4. Provide emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
5. Present a professional appearance and attitude at all times. Interact with the public in a courteous and professional manner.
6. Perform other duties as assigned by Parks & Recreation Superintendent.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES & MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. Ability to test splash pad water quality and record results are required.
3. Ability to remain vigilant and act quickly in making rescues and rendering aid.
4. Ability to establish effective working relationships and use good judgment, initiative and resourcefulness when interacting with residents, elected officials and other employees.
