Hannah Park Overlook Project
Work to begin January 13, 2025

Traverse City – Motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists should be aware that the City of Traverse City’s contractor, Walton Contracting, will be conducting work activities for the Hannah Park Overlook project near the southwest corner of the South Union Street Bridge. Work is slated to begin Monday, January 13, 2025 and be completed March 26, 2025, weather permitting.

During construction, a lane shift will be in place for the southbound lane on Union Street. The sidewalk on the west side of Union Street will be closed between Sixth Street and State Street. Pedestrians will be detoured to cross at the Sixth Street crosswalk and the controlled crossing at the Union and State Street intersection. Access to the Post Office will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be in place in and around the work area.

Work activities include removing and salvaging sidewalks, selective demolition of fieldstone walls, adjustments to existing features, and installing new elements such as clay paver bricks, concrete sidewalks, fieldstone wall veneers, railings, and wall reinforcements. These upgrades aim to enhance the overlook’s infrastructure, safety, functionality, and aesthetic appeal.
